

Strawberry Festival Vendor Information

1. Overview:

The Festival will be held on June 6th 2026 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Event is located in downtown Keyser WV on Main Street and surrounding streets. Main Street will be closed to through traffic, open only to vendor loading and unloading and foot traffic.

2. Setup & Teardown:

7:00am-9:30am: Vendors will setup

10:00 am: Festival opens to the public

3:30 pm: Earliest vendors can teardown

3. Payment:

Payment is due **no later than May 15th**. If payment is not received, your vendor spot will not be available. **We encourage online payment and registration**, however if that cannot be made, cash or check may **be mailed or dropped off** to Mineral County Parks and Recreation at 68 Armstrong Street, Keyser. WV 26726.

4. Booth Information:

Vendors are responsible for their both materials. Vendor must bring their own tables, chairs, tents, etc. Please do not exceed a booth size of 10' wide X 10' deep. If you are a food vendor and you have a food trailer/truck that will exceed the 10x10 spot please specify that on your vendor application so we can try to accommodate your size. Electricity is not available at all sites. We have a limited number of vendor spots that we can supply electricity and those will come at a first come first serve basis and prioritize to those that need them to operate their booth's function. Please call ahead of time if electric is needed for your booth.

6. Vendor Content:

Vendors are expected to stay throughout the festival. Vendor's products cannot extend out past their dedicated area. A pathway/aisle shall be maintained to help keep a flow of traffic, as well as, and not potentially cause harm to festival patrons.

7. Compliance with Federal, State, & Local Government Standards:

Each vendor is responsible for obtaining the proper federal, state, and local government licensing. Misrepresentation will result in violation. No vendor may sell age restricted products or intoxicating products. Vendors are responsible for collecting and paying all the taxes related to the sale of goods. Food vendors are responsible for contacting the local health department for obtaining all proper permits. (304-788-1321).
